ORGANISATION OVERVIEW

Netball NT is the Peak Sporting Body in the Northern Territory for netball. Netball NT is an affiliate of Netball Australia and is responsible for the development, promotion and governance of netball throughout the NT.

The major functions of Netball NT are to :

- Encourage, promote, control and manage the game of netball in the Northern Territory
- Provide leadership and co-ordination to strengthen the profile of netball at all levels of participation
- Act on behalf of members in all matters pertaining to netball

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Netball promotes cooperation, solidarity, tolerance, understanding, social inclusion and health, plus intrinsic values such as teamwork, fairness, discipline and respect for the opponent.

PROGRAMS OFFERINGS

SUNCORP NETSETGO

Suncorp NetSetGO is Netball Australia's only junior entry netball program. It provides children from 5 to 10 years with a positive introduction to netball, incorporating skill activities, minor games, music, dance and modified matches. Delivered in a fun and safe environment by accredited coaches ensures all participants have an enjoyable experience, while developing fundamental life skills.



PRODUCT OFFERING SPECIFICS

1. Suncorp NetSetGO – Minimum of one week, with daily sessions. If the program is run for longer, competitions or gala days can be arranged.
2. Inclusion NetSetGO – A modified NetSetGO program that targets older students, incorporating game play, game sense and strategic thinking. Minimum of one week, with daily sessions. If the program is run for longer, competitions or gala days can be arranged.
3. Coaching, Umpiring, Officiating and Competition Administration can be incorporated into the program to ensure sustainability, or can be run alone. Courses are run online or face-to-face with a presenter.

Netball NT can provide flexible programs to suit the needs of the participant's, ranging from a taster program through to a program delivered over a number of weeks, or an inter community carnival.
