ORGANISATION OVERVIEW

Northern Territory Cricket is the peak cricket body in the NT and we aim to unite, inspire and support all those who love the sport. Our vision is to grow the game at all levels and develop the highest possible standards of participation and performance, "from the red dust to the baggy green - cricket for all Territorians".

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Remote Red Dust Sports Voucher Program aims to provide everyone in a remote community and region with the opportunity to experience and learn the fundamentals of cricket. The program focuses on learning in a friendly and fun community environment.

Participants will have the opportunity to play cricket in an enjoyable and safe learning environment where they can build their confidence, develop new skills and play games. This program may be the first contact participants have with the game of cricket and we hope it can begin a life-long love of the sport.



PRODUCT OFFERING

MILO IN2CRICKET & MILO T20 BLAST

The MILO in2CRICKET program is designed for boys and girls from 5 to 8 years old. It is a fast, fun and active program that emphasises maximum participation, basic motor and cricket skill development. It is experience-based and builds its foundations on the essentials for lifelong involvement in physical activity and sport. This program prepares the child for MILO T20 Blast.

MILO T20 Blast has been developed to ensure junior cricketers can progress with confidence from MILO in2CRICKET to competitive club cricket competitions and play an appropriate format of cricket that will inspire them to continue as a player and a fan.

MILO T20 Blast is a graduate program and bridges the gap between MILO in2CRICKET participants and junior club cricket.

The aim of MILO T20 Blast is to:

- Introduce participants to real games of cricket
- Continue to develop skills and techniques learnt in MILO in2CRICKET
- Maximise and ensure equal participation for all participants
- Increase kids' passion for cricket



PROGRAMS INCLUDE

1. Entry Level Programs (See above) - **MILO in2CRICKET & MILO T20 Blast** (Variable length)
 - Learning and developing the key skills of cricket.
2. Community Carnival for men, women and children throughout the region. The carnival is run under a super 8's format which ensures fast paced, action packed matches.
3. Coach and Umpire Education to upskill community members. The coaching and umpiring courses will be tailored to meet the needs of the community. Courses can run anywhere from 2 hours to a full day.

Programs range from two to six weeks depending on the length of time available and community requirements. The key focus is on ensuring that cricket can continue in the region, long after the program has been delivered.

EQUIPMENT

All programs include Cricket Equipment Kits. These kits are included in the grants scheme and are to remain within the community. All equipment kits include a range of playing equipment, Educational Booklets/Resources and Certificates.

Additionally, individual participant packs can be ordered which include a bat, ball, back-pack, t-shirt, water bottle and hat for all participants to retain. Cost is dependent on the particular gear ordered.

OTHER INFORMATION

All NT Cricket deliverers are accredited, experienced and undertake culture awareness training before delivering in remote regions.
