Softball NT's vision is to provide an inclusive, accessible, and equitable environment for players of all abilities and ages. Our aim is to grow the game at all levels in a fun and positive manner that leads to empowering all participants involved.

### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Our coaches are experienced in delivering Softball in remote settings and have the knowledge and flexibility to tailor a range of programs that reflects the requirements of the community. Participants can partake in game-based activities, learning softball fundamentals of throwing, catching, and batting, through to playing matches.

Our programs emphasize activities that are engaging, inclusive and fun and that can be played on any surface such as basketball courts, recreation halls, and outdoor spaces.

Softball NT offers level 1 and 2 accredited courses in scoring and umpiring.

### PROGRAMS OFFERINGS

#### SOFTBALL BATTER UP

Softball Australia's national participation program, Softball Batter Up, is designed to be fun, flexible and engaging for children from kindergarten age to Year 6, focusing on fun activities while learning basic throwing, catching and striking skills. A successful program can be adapted for all ages and abilities using the Game Sense and CHANGE IT approach. Softball Batter Up activities align with the national health and physical education curriculum and are written with coaches and teachers in mind. Detailed information is provided on each activity's learning intention, band levels, and skill focus, together with questions to encourage participant engagement. With more than 60 different softball activities and games on offer, we can design your own softball sessions allowing for repetition over time to maximise learning and development opportunities.

### PRODUCT OFFERING SPECIFICS

1. After school sessions, from 1 week to full term programs leading into interschool or even interregional competitions.
2. Assisting the community to build and create regular competitions for kids to participate in.
3. Offer pathways for kids through talent identification and School Sport NT or Softball NT representative pathways.
4. Accreditations in Umpiring, Scoring and Coaching.

## EQUIPMENT

All programs include softball equipment kits which include:

- foam bat and four foam balls
- an outdoor bat and 3 match balls
- 1 portable tee stand
- 1 catcher set
- 9 right hand gloves
- 2 left hand gloves
- 4 helmets
- 1 set of nonslip bases
- 1 bag

This kit is included in the grant scheme for the cost of \$1,600.00 and remains in the community once the program has been delivered.

Specific gear or top up equipment for existing kits can also be arranged. The cost will be dependent on the equipment ordered.

## OTHER INFORMATION

Softball NT delivery agents are accredited and experienced program deliverers who are aware and respectful of local culture and relationships. All agents have Ochre cards.

When timing aligns, we will have Australian playing and coaching representatives to help deliver our programs.
