ORGANISATION OVERVIEW

Gymnastics Northern Territory is the governing body for Gymnastics in the NT providing grassroots and pathway opportunities for participants of all ages, genders and abilities

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

As the Peak Sporting Body for Gymnastics in the Northern Territory we can offer remote communities targeted programs that provide an environment where children of all ages and abilities can achieve success and reap the rewards of skill development, enhanced self-esteem, social cooperation and grassroots sports participation.

PRODUCT OFFERING

Gymnastics Australia's LaunchPad Gymnastics programs cater for children of all ages and are expertly designed to cater for all stages of physical, social and cognitive development. Each program is supported by 'easy to use' lesson plans for coaches and teachers that are safe, fun, require minimal equipment and align with the new Australian Curriculum.

Requirements:

- Sessions must be 45 – 60 minutes in duration
- Coach – student ratio is 1:25 (average)
- School/organisers must provide active supervision (supervising teacher becomes the assistant coach)
- Access to suitable indoor space at the school/council facilities
- School/Council to provide scatter mats (1 per 2 students) and any other gymnastic equipment that may be available
- A quote for gymnastic equipment can be arranged if required

1. **GymFun (5-8 year olds)** - In GymFun, the focus is on fundamental movement patterns that help children progress into more advanced skills or sports. The games and activities in GymFun are safe and encourage children to work with others and build self-esteem.
2. **GymSkills (8-12 year olds)** - As children develop more control of their bodies through fundamental movement, more specific activities and skills are introduced. Students are encouraged to learn, reproduce and create more complex movement sequences. Refer:

Within the Gymnastics NT remote school voucher package, the **Launchpad** Gymnastics program consists of four sessions. Delivery is flexible and can be facilitated at your school, local gymnastics club and/or a community space.

EQUIPMENT

PROGRAM INCLUSION:

- Minimum 4 x LaunchPad Gymnastics sessions per participant.
- Participants packs and teacher lesson plans can be arranged at an extra cost
- Gymnastic equipment can be arranged at extra cost

FEES

- Coaching fee's @ \$300 per day (2 preferred)
- Meal allowance @ \$94.50 per day
- Flights
- Accommodation
- Travel @ \$0.66 cents per km
- Program @ \$100 per day

OTHER INFORMATION

Our coaches hold a minimum Gymnastics Australia Intermediate coaching accreditation, ochre card and all relevant police checks. Megan Fairhall our current remote coach also holds her NT teachers license and has spent time teaching in remote NT. At times we may need to source coaches from across Australia, this will be included in the quote.
