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### ORGANISATION OVERVIEW

Since 1965, Royal Life Saving NT has been serving the community as the leader in water safety education and training throughout the Northern Territory. We can travel from the Tiwi Islands to Mutitjulu or from Gove to Wadeye to deliver water safety education and training.

### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

1. Royal Life Saving NT can assist Northern Territory communities with the coordination and delivery of aquatic programs that enhance the use of community pools. This could include delivery of the Swim and Survive Program for children aged 5 - 14 years of age.
2. For older students (14-18 years), there is the opportunity for training in a variety of aquatic courses. Bronze Medallion, First Aid and Pool Lifeguard all offer the opportunity for students to gain extra credit points towards NTEC. The added advantage being once qualified, they can gain employment at their local community pool.



### PRODUCT OFFERING SPECIFICS

The Swim and Survive Program is an all-inclusive swimming and water safety initiative of Royal Life Saving that seeks to increase swimming and water safety skills. The broad and balanced program teaches a range of skills and knowledge to develop swimming, water safety, survival and basic rescue skills.

Program Includes:

AUSTSWIM qualified swim teachers with current Working with Children Card.

A Nationally recognised program that is aligned to the National Swimming and Water Safety Framework and acknowledged by the Australian Water Safety Council.

Certificates and Administration

Training packages can be arranged to offer flexible delivery options to assist the school. Areas include basic water rescues, CPR, fitness and survival skills.

All training packages meet the Australian Government training requirements.
